



## 2021-2022 School Year Guidelines



### PPE

- WCS requires masks be worn by students, staff, and visitors indoors for all Pre-K-12 schools.
- Seating will be three-feet apart whenever possible.
- Masks and hand sanitizer will be made available to students.



### Cleaning & Screening

- Teachers will have access to classroom disinfectant.
- Enhanced daily cleaning procedures will be performed by the custodial staff.
- Staff and students should continue to monitor for symptoms before each school day.
- The district will cooperate with the Macomb County Health Department for reporting.



### School Day

- School day will return to traditional start and end times.
- Lunch schedules and seating will resume as usual.
- Students will resume using lockers.
- Building visitors and chaperones may return following traditional policy and guidelines.



### Transportation

- WCS requires masks be worn by students and staff on all school buses.
- Bus cleaning protocols will continue. Buses will be sanitized frequently.
- Masks and hand sanitizer will be made available to students.



### Athletics & Fine Arts

- Masks are required for all indoor sports, with the exception of those participating in active competition.
- Fine Arts will follow the Michigan School Band and Orchestra Association (MSBOA) procedures and guidelines.
