PAYING FOR COLLEGE/TRADE SCHOOL & STEPS TO MCC (5-15-15)

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- Federal Program—all should apply
- · Offers both GRANTS (you don't pay back) and Loans
- You do not have to finish the application all at once
- · You can do most of it on your own, but will need parents help for some
- · You do not have to "accept" all loan dollars offered

TIP (Tuition Incentive Program)

- State of Michigan Program
- Key qualifying piece is whether or not you have been on Medicaid for at least 24 out of a 36 month period (between the age of 12 to present)
- Covers full time tuition cost at MCC and most other Community Colleges—this is a BIG deal...\$2,200-\$2,700 per year

3 Steps to MCC (Macomb Community College)

- This can be accomplished in just a few weeks, but most take 4-6 weeks to complete the process.
- Don't be afraid of the placement test, but take it seriously!
- Registration for the Fall opens up in early-mid July and Winter open up for registration around early-mid November

Other Important Information

- MCC offers associate degree programs and certificate based programs...some careers do not require a "degree"
- If you plan to transfer to a university to pursue your bachelor's degree, then it is important to understand the transfer credit agreement process. It is also important to narrow your scope of your "goal" university as early as possible.
