### Title I Funding Provides

**Highly Qualified Teachers** to work with small groups to support the Core Curriculum

**Literacy Libraries:** A collection of leveled books which are used to provide guided reading instruction for students in grades K-5

**Classroom Materials:** Materials that teachers use to differentiate instruction in order to better meet individual student needs within the classroom setting and in small group settings.

**Title I Family Night** scheduled during the school year in which families and students are invited to join us for programs to enhance student learning.
